Raising the roof of our village hall Regular readers will know that we've been fundraising for a new village hall roof. The good news is that we've been successful in getting a grant from Wren Community Action Fund which will cover most of what we need and with other generous donations and fundraising activities we'll soon be replacing our leaky old roof with one which will keep the hall dry and warmer. We will aim to keep disruption to village hall activities to a minimum, but please bear with us as the improvements will be worth it.

In recent years, the North Dalton area has seen some new housing development, but new homes often prove too expensive for many local households. Affordable housing, either for rent or for sale could be the answer for those who want to stay in the village but are looking to move into more suitable housing at a price they can afford.
