1. To receive and approve apologies for absence: Cllr Mrs Dunn, Cllr Pittaway, Cllr Scott & Cllr Harrison

2. To record declarations of interest by any member of the council in respect of the agenda items listed below. Member declaring interests should identify the agenda item and type of interest being declared. (Code of Conduct, Localism Act 2011): None declared

3. To confirm as a true record the minutes of the meeting of the parish council held on Friday 21st September: the minutes of the previous meeting having previously been circulated to all councilor's councilors were discussed.

4. Matters Arising: there were no matters arising. It was requested that the clerk send the minutes to councilors within a few weeks of the meeting.

5. Notice of Decision: 18/02564/PLF – Erection of wall following demolition of existing (retrospective application) – Centre House Farm, Main Street, North Dalton, YO25 9XA – Mr Rob Conner - approved

6. Planning Applications:

18/03652/TCA – North Dalton Conservation Area: reduce height of 2 conifer trees at the rear of property by approx. 10 feet (3m) prune and shape. Prune branches of cherry tree to front due to branches hanging over garage roof and over boundary – Mulberry Cottage, Amin Street, north Dalton, YO25 9XA – Mr Terrance Langstaff – No Objections

18/03901/TCA – North Dalton Conservation Area: T1 Cypress Leylandii: remove as too large for location. T2 Cherry: prune away from overhead lines currently under tension from tree branches – South End Cottage, South End, North Dalton, YO25 9UT – Mr Andrew Cowham – No Objections

18/02530/PLF – Construction of new vehicular access and erection of field gate following alterations to existing wall – Land east of 10 Council Houses, Hill Crescent, North Dalton, YO25 9UU – Mr Lewis Holmes – Object – the parish council objected to this application as it will have a major visual impact on the conservation area of the village. The proposed access is in an elevated position where there is no public footpath, it could create traffic issues due to parked vehicles opposite it. There is no need for a future access. There is already access to the field from Back Lane which is sufficient for the field and if the applicant was to sell the front part of the field, he can grant access from Back Lane across his retained land.

7.Receipts –The clerk advise ERYC Precept second payment of £3000 had been received

8.Invoices Payable – The clerk advised the following invoices had been received for payment:

9. Any other business:

Cllr Wade asked that the council consider funding a Christmas tree for future years. This would be discussed at a meeting later next year.

The footpath outside Ransome row was moss covered again as were other village footpaths. The ERYC were aware but action to clean them was slow. The possibility of a volunteer spraying them was discussed but it was felt that liability issues could arise.

The removal of the grit bin outside the School House was discussed again. The clerk advised that the ERYC had removed the bin due to lack of use and there was no plans for its replacement. Cllr Horspool asked if one could be purchased from the ERYC. The clerk would contact Highways to establish costs, procedures etc.

CllrWade raised her concerns over crime in the village and asked about the possibility of a Neighborhood Watch Scheme could be started. Cllr Wade advised she would contact the Police herself to discuss the matter further.
